



Electronics market size stood at GEL 4.4bn in 2022





Electronics sector turnover, GEL bn




Key market players in the electronics sector, 2021






Increase in prices related to global factors and the demand for expensive products from migrants

Number of active mobile phones in Georgia by brand, mn








Demand for smartphones driven by low level of ownership and the abundance of young people

Georgian population structure, '000, 2022








Demand for computers is driven by the low level of ownership and the growth of computerized businesses

Active business entities in Georgia, '000




Number of computer-intensive businesses. Moreover, 55.6% of total employed actively uses computer
